It was a ery successful event and hundreds of people were enterained throughout the day as the EMYC members and Jack Witherby of Funtime Hobbies and his group provided a werse display of some 65 boats. Approximately 50 of those boats, half electric and half sail, were registered with radiocontrolled equipment and ran during various events and at

The interior of the Centrum building served as a focal point for an indoor display for the static models and the anning models while they were not being used on the water. the winds ended up being light for the sailors, 5 kts or less for most of the day, but the sailing group still managed to be competitive and entertaining, especially with the balloon tag event. Sailboats running in the events were the 36/600, EC12 and Marblehead class type boats. A sampling of electric hoats included a WWII submarine, Darby tug, Trawler, Coast Guard Cutter, Shrimp boats, Tournament Fishing Boat, Bart boat 1/4 scale Chris-Craft Cruisers and much more.

Judging by the number of questions asked and overall interest in the R/C boating hobby, the Parade of Model Boats proved to be a well-organized and successful first time event or the EMYC group. Thanks to all of those involved.

SAIL BOAT RACING


